 Love Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her - Ephesians 5:25

so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, ²⁷ that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless. Ephesians 5:26–27
• Love So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He
who loves his own wife loves himself; ²⁹ for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also <i>does</i> the church, ³⁰ because we are members of His body Ephesians 5:28–30
"nourish" - <i>ektrepho</i> = to, to
"cherishes" - thalpo = to make
