1. Anyone Without Jesus Is A Walking  And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, <sup>2</sup> in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience Ephesians 2:1–2
Death =
• It's an death  The LORD God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; 17 but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat for in the day that you eat from it you will surely die." - Genesis 2:16–17
When Adam sinned, sin entered the world. Adam's sin brought death, so death spread to everyone, for everyone sinned Romans 5:12 (NLT)

What Are The Contributors To Spiritual Death?
• The in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, Eph 2:2
Do not love this world nor the things it offers you, for when you love the world, you do not have the love of the Father in you. <sup>16</sup> For the world offers only a craving for physical pleasure, a craving for everything we see, and pride in our achievements and possessions. These are not from the Father, but are from this world. <sup>17</sup> And this world is fading away, along with everything that people crave. But anyone who does what pleases God will live forever 1 John 2:15–17 (NLT)
<ul> <li>The</li> <li> according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience Ephesians 2:2</li> </ul>

"prince of the power of the air" =
• The Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest Ephesians 2:3
"flesh" = the fallen that we're born with
2. Anyone With Jesus Is A
• It's life and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly <i>places</i> in Christ Jesus, - Ephesians 2:6
• It's life even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), <sup>6</sup> and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly <i>places</i> in Christ Jesus, - Ephesians 2:5–6
What Are The Contributors To Spiritual Life?
• But God, being rich in mercy - Ephesians 2:4
Mercy is not getting what you
• because of His great love with which He loved us - Ephesians 2:4
But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, seven when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), - Ephesians 2:4–5
Grace is getting what you don't
When you come to Jesus He makes you a living!

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them. - Ephesians 2:10 (NASB95)
