THE CHARACTERISTICS TO IMITATE

THE GHANAGTERIOTIOS TO IMITATE
1. Imitate God In and walk in love, - Ephesians 5:2
The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love 1 John 4:8
• Love gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God – Eph 5:2
• Love But immorality or any impurity or greed must not even be named among you, as is proper among saints; Ephesians 5:3–7
"immorality" – <i>porneia</i> = sin (any sex outside of the boundaries of)
"impurity" – akatharsía = uncleanness
2. Imitate God In for you were formerly darkness, but now you are Light in the Lord; walk as children of Light - Ephesians 5:8
 ALight (for the fruit of the Light consists in all goodness and righteousness and truth), - Ephesians 5:9
"Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven." - Matthew 5:16
An Light trying to learn what is pleasing to the Lord Ephesians 5:10

Carefully determine what pleases the Lord. - Ephesians 5:10 (NLT) • An Light Do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose them; ¹² for it is disgraceful even to speak of the things which are done by them in secret. ¹³ But all things become visible when they are exposed by the light, for everything that becomes visible is light. -Ephesians 5:11–13 • An Light
