

GRACE
just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love ⁵ He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, ⁶ to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved Ephesians 1:4–6
"chose" – eklegomai = to pick or out for one's self.
"predestined" – <i>prooizo</i> = beforehand
1. To make us before God just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love - Ephesians 1:4
and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from <i>the</i> Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which <i>comes</i> from God on the basis of faith, - Philippians 3:9
He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him 2 Corinthians 5:21
2. To make us God's He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, - Ephesians 1:5

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace ⁸ which He lavished on us. In all wisdom and insight - Ephesians 1:7–8
"redemption" – <i>apolutrosis</i> = obtained by payment of a ransom
"lavished" - perisseuo = to be and

with a view to an administration suitable to the fullness of the times, <i>that is</i> , the summing up of all things in Christ, things in the heavens and things on the earth. In Him ¹¹ also we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will, Ephesians 1:10–11
GRACE
In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise - Ephesians 1:13
"sealed" – sphragizo = to seal. Seals were used as a guarantee indicating not only but also to guarantee the of the contents
who also sealed us and gave <i>us</i> the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge. 2 Corinthians 1:22
