

Ecclesiastes 10:1-20

THE SERIOUSNESS OF FOOLISHNESS

Dead flies make a perfumer's oil stink, so a little foolishness is weightier than wisdom *and* honor. - Ecclesiastes 10:1

SIGNS THAT YOU MAY BE A FOOL

1. Foolishness Shows Up In The Way That You A wise man's heart <i>directs him</i> toward the right, but the foolish man's heart <i>directs him</i> toward the left. ³ Even when the fool walks along the road, his sense is lacking and he demonstrates to everyone <i>that</i> he is a fool. ⁴ If the ruler's temper rises against you, do not abandon your position, because composure allays great offenses Ecclesiastes 10:2-4
2. Foolishness Shows Up In The Way That You He who digs a pit may fall into it, and a serpent may bite him who breaks through a wall. ⁹ He who quarries stones may be hurt by them, and he who splits logs may be endangered by them. ¹⁰ If the axe is dull and he does not sharpen <i>its</i> edge, then he must exert more strength. Wisdom has the advantage of giving success. ¹¹ If the serpent bites before being charmed, there is no profit for the charmer Ecclesiastes 10:8-11
3. Foolishness Shows Up In The Way That You
Foolish words are Words from the mouth of a wise man are gracious, while the lips of a fool consume him; - Ecclesiastes 10:12
Like a club and a sword and a sharp arrow Is a man who bears false witness against his neighbor Proverbs 25:18
The one who guards his mouth preserves his life; The one who opens wid his lips comes to ruin Proverbs 13:3
