THE LIFE

- 1. Background
 - Brother of John Matt 4:21; Mk 1:19-20
 - Father's name was Zebedee who ran his own fishing business Mk 1:19-20
 - Mother's name was Salome and was among those who followed Jesus – compare Matt 27:56 & Mk 15:40
 - Fisherman by trade Matt 4:21; Mk 1:19-20; Lk 5:10
 - Always mentioned with his brother John except on one occasion
 - Always in top four of disciples list & in the "intimate 3"
 - Nicknamed along with his brother John "Boanerges," Sons of Thunder – Mk 3:17

James, the *son* of Zebedee, and John the brother of James (to them He gave the name Boanerges, which means, "Sons of Thunder"); - Mark 3:17
