Now he said this, not because he was concerned about the poor, but because he was a thief, and as he had the money box, he used to pilfer what was put into it. - John 12:6

### • Expert \_

When Jesus had said this, He became troubled in spirit, and testified and said, "Truly, truly, I say to you, that one of you will betray Me." <sup>22</sup> The disciples *began* looking at one another, at a loss *to know* of which one He was speaking. - John 13:21-22

### • Remorseful but \_

Then when Judas, who had betrayed Him, saw that He had been condemned, he felt remorse and returned the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, <sup>4</sup> saying, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood." But they said, "What is that to us? See *to that* yourself!" <sup>5</sup> And he threw the pieces of silver into the temple sanctuary and departed; Matthew 27:3-5
