

## THE ACTIONS OF LOVING LIKE JESUS

1.	To Love Like Jesus We're Going To Have To The
•	When Jesus came down from the mountain, large crowds followed Him. And a leper came to Him and bowed down before Him, and said, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean." Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." And immediately his leprosy was cleansed Matthew 8:1-3
•	Then it happened that as Jesus was reclining <i>at the table</i> in the house, behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and were dining with Jesus and His disciples. <sup>11</sup> When the Pharisees saw <i>this</i> , they said to His disciples, "Why is your Teacher eating with the tax collectors and sinners?" <sup>12</sup> But when Jesus heard <i>this</i> , He said, " <i>It is</i> not those who are healthy who need a physician, but those who are sick. <sup>13</sup> "But go and learn what this means: 'I DESIRE COMPASSION, AND NOT SACRIFICE,' for I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners." - Matthew 9:10–13
2.	Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come forth from God and was going back to God, <sup>4</sup> got up from supper, and laid aside His garments; and taking a towel, He girded Himself. <sup>5</sup> Then He poured water into the basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded John 13:3–5

	HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND, AND WITH ALL YOUR
	STRENGTH.' 31 "The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as
