1. Background
 from Cana in Galilee – John 21:2 listed as Bartholomew in the 4 lists of the apostles -Matt. 10:2-4; Mk 3:16-19; Lk 6:13-16; Acts 1:13
Bartholomew = of Tolmai. Full name = Bar-Tolmai, or son of Tolmai
 Introduced to Jesus by Philip – John 1:43 Only the Gospel of John contains details about him – John 1:43-51; 21:2
2. Characteristics Of His Life
 of the John 1:45 Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found Him of whom Moses in the Law and also the Prophets wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." - John 1:45
 John 1:46 Nathanael said to him, "Can any good thing come out of Nazareth?" Philip said to him, "Come and see." - John 1:46
"prejudice" = generalizations based on feelings of superiority
• of – John 1:47 Jesus saw Nathanael coming to Him, and said of him, "Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom there is no deceit!" - John 1:47
