## **THE RUINS OF WORRY**

### **1. Worry Ruins Your \_\_\_\_\_ To The World**

“Do not worry then, saying, ‘What will we eat?’ or ‘What will we drink?’ or ‘What will we wear for clothing?’” <sup>32</sup> “For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.” -  
Matthew 6:31-32

**“Gentiles” = those without God**

### **2. Worry Ruins Your \_\_\_\_\_**

“So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.” - Matthew 6:34

## **THE REPLACING OF WORRY**

### **1. Replace Worry With The Right \_\_\_\_\_**

“But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is *alive* today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, *will He* not much more *clothe* you? You of little faith! - Matthew 6:30

### **2. Replace Worry With A Right \_\_\_\_\_ Of \_\_\_\_\_**

“For all these things the Gentiles eagerly seek; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.” - Matthew 6:32

### **3. Replace Worry With The Right \_\_\_\_\_**

“But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you.” - Matthew 6:33
