THE RUINS OF WORRY
1. Worry Ruins Your To The World "Do not worry then, saying, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or 'What will we wear for clothing?' ³² "For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things." - Matthew 6:31-32
"Gentiles" = those without God
2. Worry Ruins Your "So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own." - Matthew 6:34
