## Preparing For Grief

### 1. Your Loss Does Not Mean That God Does Not \_\_\_\_\_

- Jesus genuinely \_\_\_\_\_ you – John 11:5

Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. - John 11:5

- Jesus genuinely \_\_\_\_\_ with you – John 11:35

When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews who came with her also weeping, He was deeply moved in spirit and was troubled, 34 and said, "Where have you laid him?" They said to Him, "Lord, come and see." 35 Jesus wept. - John 11:33–35

### 2. Your Loss Does Not Mean That God Is Not In \_\_\_\_\_

But when Jesus heard about it he said, "Lazarus's sickness will not end in death. No, it happened for the glory of God so that the Son of God will receive glory from this." - John 11:4 (NLT)

### 3. Your Loss Does Not Meant That God Is Not \_\_\_\_\_

Martha then said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died." - John 11:21

Therefore, when Mary came where Jesus was, she saw Him, and fell at His feet, saying to Him, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died." - John 11:32

### 4. Your Loss Does Not Mean That There is No \_\_\_\_\_

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, <sup>26</sup> and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?" - John 11:25–26
