1.	TheLeads To Loneliness Then I looked again at all the acts of oppression which were being done under the sun. And behold <i>I saw</i> the tears of the oppressed and <i>that</i> they had no one to comfort <i>them;</i> and on the side of their oppressors was power, but
	they had no one to comfort <i>them.</i> - Ecclesiastes 4:1
	Warning: Oppression can drive you from others
2.	Leads To Loneliness I have seen that every labor and every skill which is done is <i>the result of</i> rivalry between a man and his neighbor. This too is vanity and striving after wind Ecclesiastes 4:4
	*Envy = something that others have (success, blessing, possessions, etc)
	Warning: Jealous envy can drive others from you
3.	Leads To Loneliness Then I looked again at vanity under the sun. ⁸ There was a certain man without a dependent, having neither a son nor a brother, yet there was no end to all his labor. Indeed, his eyes were not satisfied with riches and he never asked, "And for whom am I laboring and depriving myself of pleasure?" This too is vanity and it is a grievous task Ecclesiastes 4:7-8

	Brethren, even if anyone is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; <i>each one</i> looking to yourself, so that you too will not be tempted Galatians 6:1
