Ephesians 2:11-22
THE GOSPEL DESTROYS WHAT NEEDS TO
1. The Gospel Destroys Walls Therefore remember that formerly you, the Gentiles in the flesh, who are called "Uncircumcision" by the so-called "Circumcision," which is performed in the flesh by human hands— Ephesians 2:11
2. The Gospel Destroys Walls
There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus Galatians 3:28
3. The Gospel Destroys Walls remember that you were at that time separate from Christ, excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world Ephesians 2:12
THE GOSPEL CONSTRUCTS WHAT NEEDS TO
1. The Gospel Builds Up An Extraordinary So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household, - Ephesians 2:19
But you are A CHOSEN RACE, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR <i>God's</i> OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; ¹⁰ for you once were NOT A PEOPLE, but now you are THE PEOPLE OF GOD; you had NOT RECEIVED MERCY, but now you have RECEIVED MERCY 1 Peter 2:9–10
2. The Gospel Builds Up An Extraordinary having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner <i>stone</i> , in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord, ²² in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit Ephesians 2:20–22
