The Meaning And when He had taken <i>some</i> bread <i>and</i> given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me." ²⁰ And in the same way <i>He took</i> the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood." - Luke 22:19-20
