Getting Down to Business:

The following questions are following this format: Scripture, Observation, Application, and Prayer (SOAP).

- 1) **Scripture:** Again reflecting on the sermon from last Sunday, answer one of these questions: A. What passage(s) of scripture were most meaningful to you? And why? B. What passage(s) of scripture did you learn most from? And why? C. What other passage(s) from scripture, not referred to in this sermon, are related to the topic? And how does this passage compare to the sermon topic?
- 2) **Observation:** Read 1 Corinthians 10:16-18 below. How does this passage link the Lord's supper with the fellowship of believers?

1 Corinthians 10:16-18, NLT

¹⁶When we bless the cup at the Lord's Table, aren't we *sharing* in the blood of Christ? And when we break the bread, aren't we *sharing* in the body of Christ? ¹⁷And though we are many, we all eat from one loaf of bread, showing that we are one body. ¹⁸Think about the people of Israel. Weren't they *united by eating* the sacrifices at the altar? [words italicized for emphasis]

- 3) **Application:** Now that you understand more of what fellowship should be among believers how will this change your view of church?
- 4) **Prayer:** Guide your group to pray that the fellowship among yourselves and that of the church body would grow.
